ICELANDIC AUDITIONS FOR TOP BRITISH DRAMA ACADEMY

This year, for the first time ever, the London Academy of Music and Dramatic Art (LAMDA) will be hosting auditions in Iceland for entry to the Academy in September 2005. Held in Reykjavik on Saturday 4th and Sunday 5th June 2005, these auditions will provide the perfect opportunity for anyone interested in acting or directing to meet LAMDA representatives and discover more about the top-calibre training the Academy can offer.

LAMDA is one of the leading drama schools in the English-speaking world, with a long-established and international reputation for excellence. Few cast-lists are empty of its alumni and scarcely a year goes by without LAMDA's former students being honoured at a major film, theatre or television award ceremony. LAMDA's stage managers are also leaders in the arts world enjoying a 98% employment rate directly after graduation, its alumni work in the top theatres, TV and film companies, as well as excelling in the corporate sector.

The training at LAMDA is vocational and no academic qualifications are required for entry. The Academy welcomes applications from all sections of the community, regardless of ethnicity, religion, gender, sexuality or disability. Its only restriction is that students must be at least 18 years old at the beginning of each course.

This June, LAMDA will be auditioning for entry to its Three Year Professional Acting Course, Two Year Professional Acting Course, One Year Director's Course and One Year Foundation Course.
