## HOW TO COMPLETE THIS FORM

1. All applicants complete this section. All correspondence from LAMDA Examinations will be directed to the correspondence contact.
2. Enter the learner details.
  - a. Unique Learner Number (ULN): Please enter the learner's 10 digit Unique Learner Number (if known)
  - b. LAMDA Pin No: Please enter the learner's 6 digit LAMDA Pin number (must be given)
  - Learner's Name: This is the learner's legal name and not nickname or abbreviated name. It will be printed on the Certificate
  - c. Given Name: This is the learner's first name
  - d. Family Name: This is the learner's surname
  - e. Date of Birth: Please complete in numbers, in the format DD/MM/YY
  - f. Gender: Please enter M or F
  - g. Ethnicity Code: Please enter a code from the list on page 2
3. Only complete this if the learner is associated with a private centre.
4. Tick the appropriate subject being claimed for the Joint Qualification.
5. Tick the appropriate level being claimed for the Joint Qualification.
6. Enter the learner's three qualifying constituent components for the Joint Qualification.
  - i. Subject Title: Enter the name of the subject title e.g. 'Speaking Verse and Prose'

### Claim Criteria

Learners must successfully complete three qualifying constituent components. These must be three different subjects from the lists below.

#### Qualifying Communication Subjects

Speaking Verse and Prose  
Using Spoken English or Speaking in Public  
Reading for Performance

#### Qualifying Performance Subjects

Acting (solo or duologue)  
Miming (solo or duologue)  
Devising Drama (solo or duologue)  
Musical Theatre for the Actor/Singer (solo or duologue)

All three qualifying constituent components must be completed within a 24 month period, which begins on the date the first qualifying constituent component is awarded.

The level of the Joint Qualification awarded is determined by the lowest component's subject grade of the three qualifying constituent components being used to make the claim. See the back page for qualifying component combination examples.

A qualifying components subject can be used more than once for separate claims.

A qualifying component can be from a current or previous syllabus.
